He then made his way here to Abbotsford with the help of Grace Church and was joined by his wife and three daughters as the fourth was married and living in the US. He managed to plant an Iranian church in North Vancouver and helped other pastors with whatever way he could, but due to his age and distance from Abbotsford, he gave the church over to others in the area but on occasion went back to deliver a sermon at times. As a devoted man of God, he gave of himself whatever and to whom ever needed help.
