I have many fond memories our long friendship. Our mother's knew each other and they would get together when we were babies. Alie (that's how I knew her) and I were 2 weeks apart, and when ever our mother's would get together, they would just lay us in the crib together.

When we were 3 we started Kindergarten. Unfortunately we went to different elementary schools, but every Sunday we would go to Sunday school together and even after, when we got older, we would still get together on Sundays.

After elementary school Alie started to work for a lady who made hats. I remember she made a really beautiful muff one time and a very pretty green velvet barret. She also was very good at styling hair and did mine many times.

When she was 18 she left for Canada. We still saw each other a few times till I left for Australia in 1956. My family and I came back to Holland in 1970 and we got to see each other in Holland when she would come to visit. She came for a surprise visit on my 50th wedding anniversary, which was very special.

The last few years we would talk on the phone fairly regularly and I will really miss that.
