Donat Leonard Paquette, known as Don, of Abbotsford, B.C., born in Las Pas, Manitoba on September 9th, 1931 to Leonard and Lena Paquette, passed away peacefully at Abbotsford Menno Home East 1 on July 12th, 2020 at the age of 88.

Don also was an Executive Board Member of "B.C. Minor Baseball" for 36 years. He also coached many different minor levels of baseball teams in these same towns.

In his retirement, Don enjoyed woodworking, rounds of golf, coffee with his cronies, picking blueberries at Paul's farm, making perogies with Bill and Emily Ruzicky, and watching his grandsons play baseball.
