It is with sadness that the family of Gwendoline Watson (nee Lintern) announces her passing. Gwen was born in Luton, England on July 25, 1925. She trained and worked as a lab bacteriologist in London, England. In 1956 she came to Canada to spend a year working at the Vancouver General and then Pearson Hospitals. During her stay she met Hamish Watson at the Mission to Seafarers Flying Angel Club on the Vancouver waterfront; they were married in 1958 and settled in Vancouver.
