Jacob William Born (Jake)

Jacob "Jake" Born of Abbotsford passed away on Wednesday, May 17th at the age of 96. He is survived by his wife Hilda (nee Klassen) to whom he was married for nearly 70 years.

He is also survived by his five children David (Loraine), Teresa, John (Ellie), J. Bryan (Teresa) and Matthew (Debbie) as well as his 14 grandchildren and 26 great-grandchildren.
