On April 19, 2017, in Abbotsford, BC, Jim went to meet the Saviour he loved and served since age 12. Predeceased by his parents, Jim and Ada Emily Wright, he is survived by his beloved wife, Patricia, sister-in-law, Diana (Roy), nieces and nephews, and grandnieces and grandnephews; also many cousins. Born in Vancouver in 1929, he attended General Brock Elementary School and John Oliver High. An alumnus of UBC, Jim was a teacher of languages in Kamloops, Prince Rupert and North Vancouver, retiring from Carson Graham Secondary in 1988.
