She was a gifted artist and teacher, making this her full-time profession until the studio was closed with their retirements. Rilla kept the artistic side of her alive after discovering a second passion for watercolors; and through this interest she met a group of like-minded artists, instructors, and other students whose friendships she valued deeply right up to her final days. A lover of dogs and cats alike (but mostly dogs) there were many four-legged friends in the home through the years.
